

WATER MANAGEMENT PRACTICES

FOR THE END OF RICE SEASON

As the rice irrigation season comes to a close, Glenn-Colusa Irrigation District reminds all water users to adhere to the District's Water Management and Conservation Policy. This will ensure that GCID maintains a sufficient water supply for the remainder of the season.

Please also be aware that there is a cost paid by the District for every acre-foot of Project Water diverted, so adhering to the District's Water Management and Conservation Policy will lower the District's expenses and help keep water rates as low as possible.

Notched weir boards should be installed in all drain boxes District-wide. While compliance has been very good overall, there are still boxes that need weir boards installed. Water Operators have boards in their trucks and will be happy to assist you with this effort.

When preparing for harvest, water users should turn off the water to fields as early as possible and hold the water for at least 7 to 10 days before draining. Water Operators will work with water users to return water to the top check, if it should dry out faster than anticipated.
