

# Winter Water Use

Glenn-Colusa Irrigation District (GCID) is asking water users to begin flooding fields for winter water use as soon as feasible for your operations to support Keswick's steady release schedule through the month of October. GCID believes this action is necessary to decrease the demand curve to ensure that winter water is used efficiently throughout GCID.

It is projected that large amounts of water will be used this winter water season. The Upper Sacramento Scheduling Team, consisting of various fishery agencies and U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, have agreed on a plan to hold Keswick releases at 7,000 cfs through October, and then quickly decrease in early November to the winter water flow of 4,000 cfs.
